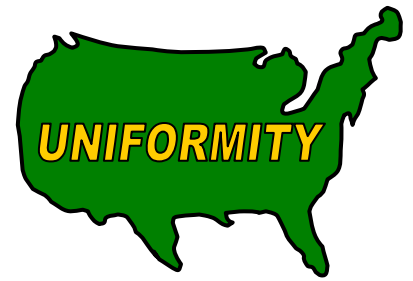

2005 IABFLO National Conference

This year will mark the 70th anniversary for IABFLO. Over the years we have seen many changes in the bedding and upholstered furniture industry. 2005 is shaping up to be one of the busiest on record.

California TB 603 just went into effect, TB 604 is on the horizon, CPSC is on the verge of passing a Federal Flammability Standard and they are also looking at "Top of the Bed" items. We just went through a major law label change with the elimination of the old blank stamp block and the addition of the TB 603 notice at the bottom of the label. We will be working with the Consumer Product Safety Commission as to what labeling requirements they will require when the Federal Flammability Standard goes into effect.

Our speakers will include Jason Hartman with the CPSC Office of Compliance and Constance Vecellis, Sr. Staff Attorney with the FTC. We also will be discussing secondhand issues and Lauren Slivenski with Hygenia USA will be demonstrating a new product to test secondhand articles.
